- If you'd like to do a video instead of an essay, please submit a minimum of 30-60 second video showing off skills, stating things you've learned, or telling us why you love your time at Gymnastics Beat. You may include anything else that you feel would reflect who you are.

Upon completion of the application, scan all documents required above and email them to <u>info@gymnasticsbeat.com</u> or submit them to the front office during business hours.

Applications not complete or received after the deadline of <u>December 10, 2024</u>, will not be considered. The recipient will be notified via email during the month of January after the Scholarship Committee has met and deliberated on the applications received.
